To our guests: Thank you for coming! We hope that worship is a blessing to you today. As part of our worship, an offering is taken to support the ministries of Kelloggsville Church. TODAY AT KELLOGGSVILLE

-It is the first Sunday of the month, and so there is **group prayer time** at 9:00 AM. *We are now meeting in the former infant nursery, located directly across from the Worship Center.*

-Pastor Martin preaches at our **9:30 AM service**, continuing a series on the Fruits of the Spirit.

-**Nursery** for children aged 0-3 takes place today during the service. The Nursery is located directly across from the Worship Center, and you may drop off children any time before or during the service.

-**Children's Worship** for kids in PreK-2nd Grade takes place today during the service. Children will be dismissed from "big church" to their Worship Centers at the appropriate time. The CW rooms are located down Stairway A and to the left.

-The **Kids' Bin** just outside the church office has worship helps for children 3rd grade and up. At the end of the service, please return reusable items (pencils, etc.).

-**Refreshments** will be served immediately following the worship service in the Family Life Center (gym).

-**Discovery**, our Bible training and faith building ministry for all ages, is at 11 AM today. The Discovery bell will ring a couple of minutes before 11 AM, to signify that it is time to go to class. Class locations are as follows:

- Discovery Tots (0-3 years): Nursery
- Discovery Kids (PreK-5th): Room 4 on lower level (kids should be dropped off by a parent/guardian)
- Discovery MS (6th-8th grades): Room 5 on lower level
- Discovery HS (9th-12th): Church Office Commons
- Discovery Adults (College+): Family Life Center

-The **adult Discovery class** will be led by **Rev. Emily Vanden Heuvel**, who will lead a talk titled "*Trauma-Informed Ministry*". A new buzz-word being thrown around schools, health care facilities and churches is "trauma-informed". For those in ministry, the word "trauma-informed" can be confusing to the local church's mission. How should the church respond? Emily has been working for over 20 years in ministry, the last 12 years

as chaplain in a residential facility offering spiritual support to the children who live on campus.

-The **French service** takes place in the Lower Level Ministry Center at 12:30 PM. The **Chin Church service** takes place at 1PM in the Worship Center.

NEXT SUNDAY AT KELLOGGSVILLE

-Pastor Martin will preach at our **9:30 AM service**, continuing a series on the Fruits of the Spirit. We will be looking at the fruits of kindness and goodness.

-As part of our worship service, we will participate in the sacrament of the **Lord's Supper**. At Kelloggsville Church we have open communion, meaning that if you believe in Jesus as your Lord and Savior, you are invited to the Lord's Supper. We also invite baptized children, at the discernment of their parents or guardians, to participate in this meal.

-Our **second morning offering** will be for **Access of West Michigan**. The mission of Access is to be a faith-based leader in linking congregational, individual, and community resources to eliminate hunger and reduce the impact of poverty in Kent County. Access provides valuable insight and support to our church in the area of benevolence requests that we receive from our community.

-Immediately following the morning worship service, there will be a **brief (15 minute) congregational meeting**. Adult members will be asked to stay for this meeting, while children, youth, and adult guests/non-members will be invited to go to the FLC for fellowship time.
