

## TODAY AT KELLOGGSVILLE

-A blessed **Easter** to you! Join us for breakfast from 8:30-9:15 AM in the Family Life Center (church gym), followed by our **worship service** in the Worship Center at 9:30 AM. Pastor Martin is our preacher.

Millions are affected in the countries of Mozambique, Malawi, and Zimbabwe. Survivors are struggling to obtain food, clean water, and shelter, and World Renew is mobilizing to help the most vulnerable. Please consider how you can give to help them in these efforts.
